The direct classes don't have the overall result, only a daily results, without prize giving. Entries on the direct classes are allowed on site too. For the Italians (or the foreign competitors members of an Italian club) a valid medical certificate is required.

BIB NUMBERS

Each competitor registered in advance will receive a bib number. Please collect them at the event office (Thursday June 18th or at the race arenas). The start times will be indicated on the bib. Please write on the back of the bib your medication and relevant medical situations.

Free punching start (within 1h 30m of the first start) for MW10, Direct and Beginner classes.

TIMING AND PUNCHING SYSTEM

Sportident with Air+ will be used as punching and timing system. Sportident classic punching can be used. There are no SIACs available for renting (only classical Sicards can be rented).

The control point code is only present on the Sportident stations. In the case of a non-functioning station, manual punching on your map is required.

CHANGE OF SICARD/SIAC

Please notify the event office of any changes to your Sicard/SIAC, before of your start. The change is free of charge.

MEDICAL RECOMMENDATIONS

If you regularly take medication or have any high-risk allergies (to medication or to insect bites), please inform the organization and take your life-saving medication with you during the race. On the back of the bib you may provide clinical information useful in case of rescue.

CAR PARKING

Stage 1 and 2: the parking is in the nearby of the arena. There are limited slots! We ask all participants to travel from Farra d'Alpago only in vehicles with at least four occupied seats. It's possible to park just before the final climb (9km from the arena) in the public parking ([46.121590,12.354924](#) payment required).

Stage 3: the main parking is located about 800m from the arena ([46.065187,12.404447](#)) an additional parking is 1.7km from the arena ([46.059045,12.400840](#)). Parking free of charge.

MOTOR HOMES PARKING

Stage 1 and 2: It's not possible to reach the arena with motor homes. You can park in Farra d'Alpago public parking ([46.121590,12.354924](#) payment required, you can sleep there during the night without taking out tables, tents...) or at the nearby [Camping Sarathei](#). From the public parking there is a **shuttle service** provided by the organizers (free of charge). You must book the shuttle service filling this module: <https://forms.gle/xssLqkJveMQhtyKC6> within the deadline of the entries (June 9th).

Stage 3: Near the car parking there is a motor home area (30 places, payment required, about 1km from the Archeton arena [46.067012, 12.402792](#)). Camping is forbidden throughout the Cansiglio Plateau outside this area. Car parking can be used to park the motor homes but not to camp during the night.

WC

Toilets are located in the nearby of the finish. There are no toilets at the start.

CONTROL DESCRIPTIONS

TRAININGS

There will be two trainings with flags available from Wednesday June 17th, afternoon. More information will follow.

FIRST AID

There is the possibility to ask medical assistance at the finish, at the start or at the refreshment points in the forest. We would like to remind you that if you notice someone in need of assistance, you must stop your race and give aid.

WITHDRAWALS AND MAXIMUM TIME

Competitors wishing to withdraw must cross the finish line (to switch off their SIAC). The maximum time limit is 2 hours for the first and the third stages, 3 hours for the second stage. After 2 and 3 hours respectively from the last start, the controls points will be collected.

MAPS AFTER THE FINISH

Competitors are allowed to keep their map after the finish. We ask you to respect the principles of fair play and not to show the map to a competitor who has not yet started.

On the last day only the maps of the M21E and W21E classes (WRE race) will be collected by the finish staff, writing the bib number on the map.

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

At the end of the last competition day there will be a prize giving ceremony.

On the classes M21E and W21E will be awarded the first 6 positions on the sum of the times of the three races. Moreover, for these two classes there will be a prize for the first 6 positions on the last day results (WRE race).

On the classes MW10, MW12, MW14, MW16, MW18, MW20, MW21A, MW21B, M35, MW40, MW45, MW50, MW55, M60, MW65, MW70, MW75 will be awarded the first 3 positions on the sum of the time of the three races.

There will be no prizes for direct and beginner classes, except for those born after 01/01/2016 who will receive a participation medal.
